### **REFERENCE:**

By letter dated April 11, 2022, the Honourable Minister of Labour and Social Security pursuant to Section 9 (3)(a) of the Labour Relations and Industrial Disputes Act of 1975 (hereinafter called "the Act"), referred to the Industrial Disputes Tribunal for settlement in accordance with the following Terms of Reference, the industrial dispute described therein: -

The Terms of Reference were as follows:

"To determine and settle the dispute between Jamaica Civil Aviation Authority on the one hand and Jamaica Air Traffic Controllers Association on the other hand over the Union's Claim for Increased Wages and other Improved Benefits for the period April 2021 to March 2023."

At the First Emergency Sitting held in the matter, the parties disagreed with the Terms of Reference and by letter dated April 21, 2022, the Tribunal informed the Ministry for consideration to be given to amending the Terms of Reference. By letter dated April 26, 2022, the Honourable Minister returned the Terms of Reference to the Tribunal, unchanged.


## **SUBMISSIONS AND SITTINGS:**

Brief was submitted by the Authority only. Three (3) Emergency Sittings were held and an Order to Refrain from Industrial Action was issued on April 14, 2022, at the 1<sup>st</sup> Emergency Sitting as well as an Order to Cease Industrial Action was issued on April 22, 2022, at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Emergency Sitting. The 3<sup>rd</sup> Emergency Sitting was held on May 6, 2022. Two (2) Sittings were held on June 14, 2022 and July 27, 2022.

### **REPORT TO THE TRIBUNAL:**

At the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sitting of the Tribunal on July 27, 2022, the parties informed the Tribunal that the matter has been settled at the local level by way of a Heads of Agreement between the parties on June 27, 2022 and that a joint letter signed by the parties will be sent to the Tribunal.

On August 2, 2022, the Tribunal received a letter dated July 29, 2022, from DunnCox, Attoneys-at-Law, representing the Company, enclosing a joint letter signed by the parties dated July 27, 2022 (copies attached) which confirmed that the matter has been settled at the local level.






# **AWARD:**




